EMA Insult Holocaust Families

1 Is the European Medicines Agency asleep at the wheel... or just asleep? Holocaust survivors and their descendants asked the European regulator of medicines to halt the Covid-19 inoculation programme, in order to avoid a second Holocaust.

2 The EMA said they will not halt the rollout. The EMA also told the Holocaust survivors that comparison with the Holocaust "might be perceived as demeaning the suffering and dignity of those who experienced the terrible events of the Holocaust."
The very people they were addressing, in other words.

3 Are the EMA asleep? If not, it looks as if they have taken "woke" [as distinct from awake] to a wholly new level of stupidity, which is saying something.

4 Telling Holocaust survivors and families that they shouldn't talk about the Holocaust, because someone might get upset, would be funny if it were not so awful.

5 Dr Juan Garcia Burgos, the Head of Public and Stakeholders Engagement Department, whose name is at the end of the letter to the Holocaust families, did not have his brain engaged when he wrote that letter, in my view.

6 The question is, who at the EMA made the original assessment on the jabs? Who at the EMA has now decided to ignore the warning by the Holocaust families – and frankly so many others – including high-standing doctors and scientists around the world?

7 Because it looks to me as if the EMA are asleep at the wheel.
