Andy Burnham Has A Vision!

I have a dream – it's my dream – and it's not your dream!

- 1 While many breathe a sigh of relief that K.Starmer has tendered his resignation and is now stepping down – perhaps even more of us are bracing themselves for a continuation of the same – or even worse!

Without a hint of an election being called – which would give the country an opportunity to voice an opinion on these recent developments, with just one single kiss in a box – the whole country is about to inherit another new PM. And this one, we are told, has a Vision – something which the last outgoing incumbent didn't have – at least as many considered.

How grateful should people feel, that - at long last - there's a Visionary arriving, just in time to rescue our crew of **65+million**, currently adrift in the sea mist without a single rudder - or an idea about anything - among us all.

- 4 **Roz Savage** spoke warmly of the idea that part of the new PM's thinking - er Vision - is the movement of some Westminster powers into the shires. Well, on the face of it, this sounds like a good move - but is it Roz? On the face of it - it sounds like the seat of power is moving closer to the people. Yes. But in reality - and in this man's head - is it the opposite of that? Are people going to feel the control of government getting right up close to their very own front doors? Patters of behaviour suggests, that is how it will be.

And what we can see happening, is this. Local councillors will blame central government for policy decisions made by government. Government will blame local councils for policy decisions made by councils. We will have all these types pointing their fingers at someone else - all beautifully confusing!

- 5 What people might be fearing - and quite reasonably one might think - is that we are all heading for a thick wedge of Top-Down management and control. And all that control will be labelled - as being for our very own safety and convenience. And if anyone believes that idea for just one minute, maybe they are still trying to clear away that sea mist - from their Vision.

But speaking of their Vision. In fact, speaking of the Vision that **65+million people** have - what gems could be brought forth if they were ever invited? Well, to date in this current system of politics, their contribution - their Vision - has never been invited. But just imagine for a moment it was. Personally, I know I'd be blown away with the magnificent ideas school children alone could bring forth. And when I say school children, I include primary children here and right down to the age of **6years**. Have you read my piece about young **Teddy** - or seen the **BBC** article about him? He was that age when he started a movement on the south coast of Hampshire, connected with recycling plastic. He showed the way forward for thousands of highly paid executives and politicians - who were still wandering around in that sea mist.

But Teddy is just one young lad - among thousands - even millions. Imagine for one moment what might come forward if the country invited all our school children to peer out from their crow's nests - to share with us what they see. And that is just the children!

- 6 There is a connection to be made here – three major connections in fact.

The First

What I'm suggesting is that the whole country is invited to peer out and share with us their Visions of a way forward. What a magnificent result that might bring to us all. But, but - and let's be real here. Such an invite will never come forth from any of the **650 politicians** we have in parliament today. No, there is zero chance of that happening with this group of people.

It is not how 'control' of the population works for these types. SMPs are party people and their unwritten loyalty is to their party – and frankly – only their party. You can see this yourself on any day in parliament. Innocent people are bombed to death in Gaza – and not a word of outrage is allowed from the good party members – except for one or two strays. One SMP in the last parliament was an exception to this unspoken rule, which controls nearly every SMP party member. His name, **Andrew Bridgen**. Despite the discomfort he endured, the attacks, the shunning and not least the offered bribes to shut him up – Andrew stayed true to himself and the people who elected him to that place. The only man in that place then showing integrity. On a count, I only see a precious few in today's parliament with any of that.

The Second

But here's a Vision for you to ponder. What if – at the next general election – a party came to power, having gained the majority of seats in parliament. Immediately following which, they brought forward a Bill to outlaw all parliamentary parties and then – when it became law – disbanded, along with all the other political parties. The Third

Sifted, sorted and carefully honed, those Visions - thought to be the best overall - would make their way up the levels of People Council debates. Ultimately, the final agreed Visions would be formerly adopted at national level. Once there, implementation processes are set in motion by a People's Council - appointing the new administrative body – to effect the People's Visions.

It sounds fairly simple – but really it wouldn't be of course. But, it is possible and it would be so much better than what people have endured now for centuries. Think of it as **The People's Reset** – a reset for **2029**.

It would be nothing less than an evolution – an evolution in politics and society generally – and a milestone in humanity's story.

- K. The lies and deception surrounding all to do with the Covid 19 story
- L. The antiquated systems and procedures of parliamentary processes
Parliamentary petition debates being one such process
And the list goes on and on – in no order of prominence

What people do not need, is any more SMPs with a misty view of life – with no drive to make a good song and dance on major subjects, like those above. Or, importantly, any who think their Vision is the only swinger in town. The people have The Vision – and it's time we all heard it – and actioned it! PS1 [Daniel Ellsberg](#) is a name many will not remember or have heard. He was a man of true standout integrity – standing head and shoulders over us all. Due to what he learned about his government, he risked his life – or his life in prison – for attempting to save countless lives of others. Those others being in US combat posts and the innocent people of Vietnam.

The award-winning film – [The Post](#), released in **2017** – explains what he did, placing the saving of lives of so many others, before his own. If you want to know what integrity is really about – watch this film.

Interestingly, Daniel Ellsberg – after leaving the armed services - had worked for the American **Rand Corporation**. That corporation's paper about Russia makes an interesting read indeed. Not intended for public release, it informs of how US policy was orchestrated to destabilise and exhaust Russia in a variety of ways – and all for unjust purposes.

Daniel Ellsberg also features in the powerful documentary – [The Trust Fall](#) – by **Kym Staton**. It tells the story of how governments act against people with integrity. If there is one message you can take from this documentary – a documentary about freedom of speech, government lies and oppression – you will understand we've arrived now at a point of change. The film is about another person with the highest grade of integrity – [Julian Assange](#).

There are other greats of course – [Edward Snowden](#) to name one other.

PS2 The book **Roz Savage** has written is called [The Ocean In A Drop](#). The first thing Roz says – before the book begins – is, our civilisation is collapsing. This is usually interpreted as bad news. There is, however, good news, she says. Which is, we're already part of helping to create a new and better one.

Roz's Vision of a new and better future – as described in the book - breaks the paradigm with which we are all too familiar. It's a paradigm of dominance, where someone always dominates over someone else - both individually and collectively - where profit and money are often involved.

Wouldn't our world be better if, instead of domination being desired – and rewarded – we had a world in which people and planet thrive together as one? That is the question Roz is asking in this book. Who among us would give any answer other than YES? Other than those people and groups who currently wield power over others, perhaps. Perhaps one question we all need to ask ourselves is this. If people cannot be relied upon to behave well towards ourselves, one another and our world, how is it that people who have power over others can be trusted to do exactly that?

Roz's Vision for the future involves co-evolution, connection, compassion and – wait for it - a complete absence of party politics. In fact, this Vision Roz holds does NOT involve a top-down system of governance. In complete contrast, she paints a picture of a system that values and rewards the skills of conflict resolution, compassionate communication [a term I prefer to "non-violent communication] and creative collaboration.

Doesn't this sound far better than our current system in which the opposite qualities are valued and rewarded?

The stand-out point Roz makes in this book is that she believes a better future is possible. Now, there is no indication that she is sharing her Vision in her little parliament enclave. So far, she has remained totally silent. Not only about a better future, but moreover, about the grim present I noted above. Perhaps she feels that she won't be supported. I'd say that people outside parliament are ready and waiting.

Maybe – just maybe – Roz is waiting for a sign. A sign that she is not simply a lone voice – but rather a latent loud voice and part of a change movement. A movement for positive change, in which the people involved are joined not only at the hip – as they march – but at the head where they Vision and importantly - at the heart, where we all connect with each other. So many people do share the same Vision – and are ready to make it happen. Humanity is ready for this change.

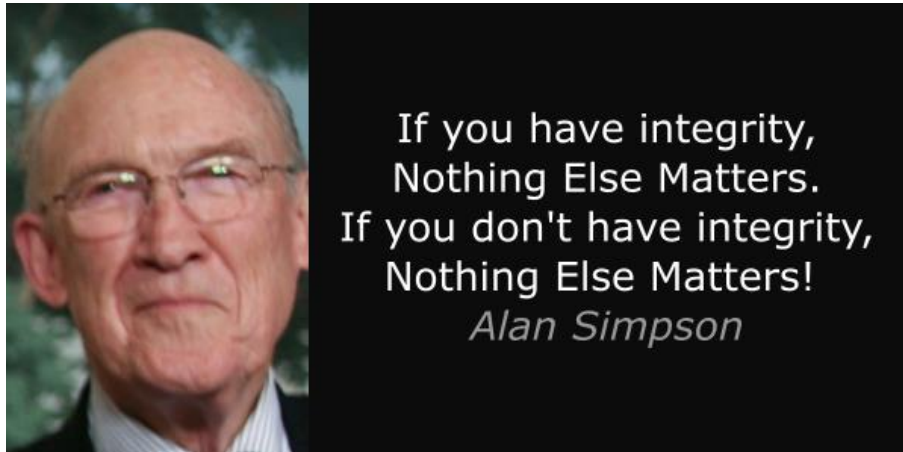
