There Is Nowhere To Go

Have we arrived at a dead end OR are we at a Fawke in the road?

- 1 For so many decades now, the people of the UK and other parts of the world, have held their heads high and proclaimed - how lucky we are to live in a democratic society.
- 2 We have all seen that democratic society in full operation too - confirming for us all the accepted process of periodic and fixed term elections. As a result of which - by democratic means - we decide as a nation on who gets the honour to lead us. The thing is - this is all "*fake news*" and now it's being realised.
- 3 The definition of democracy is subtly different for different people - depending on who you ask. The problem being that the man in the street - meaning just about everyone who is not a scholar in this field - has never thought for too long about what democracy actually means to them. Or perhaps more like - what it should mean to them.

The online and free dictionary [Merriam Webster](#) offers three goes at it - calling them essential meanings:
 1. A form of government in which people choose leaders by voting
 2. In a democracy, every citizen should have the right to vote
 3. A situation in which everyone is treated equally and has equal rights
 The dictionary expands on the above - with a fuller definition - adding:
 - a. Government by the People - rule of the majority
 - b. a government in which the supreme power is vested in the people and exercised by them directly or indirectly through a system of representation usually involving periodically held free elections
 It is high time that we - being those in the street - carefully and thoughtfully construct a visualisation of what democracy in this modern world of ours should look like. Having a visualisation and a consensus on that visualisation - we could set about building it.
- 4 This is a truly fascinating topic. But the topic is not the centre point of this particular article. I will return to the subject of Democracy another time - since it is so BIG and is so IMPORTANT to us all - and particularly at this point in our history.

But in this article, I wanted to lift the lid – shed some light – on the some of the clear inadequacies of the system of democracy we have – and do so by looking at two countries in the process – the UK and the USA.

5 Let's look first at the reality of the situation we have. In the UK we get to vote every 5years, unless the ruling party – that party with the most seats in parliament – decide to have an election earlier. This is a constitutional right of course. But note - it was a constitutional right that was decided on by the ruling party.

In other words – not by the country as a whole.

The People didn't decide they wanted this – the ruling party did.

Now this is an interesting thought on its own. Here then we have a ruling party – those with a majority the 650 seats in the UK parliament, deciding when an election is best to be held. They decide what is strategically best for them – their party - rather than what the wider country may think.

In the USA, this is not possible. The fixed term elections for the president are fixed at 4yrs. Elections are held in November, after which the winning candidate begins their term of office 2mths later in January.

This arrangement is better – but it is far from good enough.

6 The major problem with this particular system of democracy – which is common to the UK and USA versions – is that once the end of term elections are done and dusted, the People have no further involvement in any of the political decisions made thereafter.

It is a rare event if the People are afforded the luxury of a referendum. Here they might get to choose – normally by a simple majority vote – from the options the sitting governing party decide to place on offer to the People.

In effect this means that following each election, the country is directed and administered in exactly the way the ruling party – or President – determines or thinks fit. There is no adequate check on performance and no effective control over what the ruling party – or President – does or does not do.

As has been clearly demonstrated since January 2020, not even the opposition parties can exercise effective control - and that is, if they feel they have a duty to or a desire to.

And where they don't, the picture is very dark indeed.

As for the People, they are regarded simply as an inconvenience – dealt with by the issue of a narrative – relative to the affairs happening at the time and vaguely making sense, if they do at all.

The position only changes the closer we get to the next election. It is only then that the media and the People begin to start asking searching questions.

7 As a People, we have all seen how these ruling parties and Presidents tend to behave. They have an ingrained habit to change direction on election

promises. In the worse-case scenarios – where something major happens like for example a frightful pandemic - then all election promises are out the window. One could argue that such events are godsent – enabling all the tables to be turned, thus allowing a raft of political changes to be made without due assessment or examination. Emergency powers become the only justification for anything - and are the least likely to be questioned because of their apparent emergency status.

Do the People get a say in what should happen – answer NO. Without any consultation – let alone open debate or discussion – People in the UK, the USA and other major countries of the world are now being dictated to – under the auspices of Emergency Powers.

And the People are NOT dictated to on relatively minor issues such as the baseline tax rate or health spending. Instead, the People are being told where they can go – what they must wear and who they can see. Further the People are also being TOLD what they have to agree to having injected into their sovereign bodies. This week, the UK government declares – via their BBC outlet - that all frontline [NHS workers are required to be fully injected](#) by the spring of 2022. Failure to comply means expulsion from the service.

[Sky News](#) quotes the Health Secretary, Sajid Javid, saying: *90% of NHS staff have received at least two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine, although he added that in some trusts the figure is "closer to 80%". Latest data shows that over 103,000 staff in the health service in England remained unvaccinated, as well as 105,000 domiciliary care workers.*

Keep in mind that these numbers aren't necessarily reliable. The percentages could be a lot lower and the staff numbers a lot higher.

But the bottom line then is this:
Unless these workers get the Javid jab, they will all be sacked.

This is a dictate which ignores the health status of the workers, their susceptibility to a virus, their freedom to choose their own health plan, their years of training for the position they hold and the need for their services within the NHS. It also ignores the actual low risks to others - according to a growing number of doctors around the world who are speaking out.

And the justification for these dictates – has never been subject to debate. Furthermore, anyone who has voiced criticism – let alone disagreement – has either been ignored or effectively silenced.

There was a time when the media played a role in voicing public opinion, which would serve to place a brake on the determinations and actions of the ruling parties. In the time since January 2020, the People have seen this control measure - that we have all relied upon and trusted before - itself be silenced.

8 In the case of the US president, there is another disturbing feature of this inadequate form of democracy. Joe Biden is a relatively elderly man. Age is

not important where ability shines through of course. But in the case of Joe Biden, ability is not shining through and age has become an obvious handicap. The man suffers with dementia and seemingly a most embarrassing condition of incontinence. Unfortunate, but true.

In any other country or situation – where, that is, there is the absence of a nefarious agenda – the president would step down. But not here.

[Stew Peters](#) revealed with guest Patrick Howley on his show today other damning issues surrounding Joe Biden. 9 Another point to consider before we close on Joe Biden is this. The 2020 election appears, from so many quarters, to be suspect. There is seemingly a multitude of documented reports which confirm election fraud – and they are increasing in number. And for that, read "fraud" as being on an industrial scale.

The contents of Joe Biden's daughter's diary should have been enough to expose the presidential candidate as unsuitable for the presidency. Instead, it seems the story was buried by the media.

Does this mean that some people somewhere had made up their mind that the USA were committed to Joe Biden as president – come hell or high water? It certainly appears that way.

And as we all begin to understand how so many of the mainstream media platforms are controlled – and not just by Big Pharma through their advertising spend, which gives them enormous sway on what's published – we can begin to understand how stories on Joe Biden can be suppressed so to meet someone's agenda.

And the People?

Well, this is the very point of this article.

There is no forum – no mechanism – and nowhere to go – to gain a halt on proceedings and a subsequent process which would hold all the politicians to account. The People are in effect totally powerless when it comes to the question "What can we all do about this?"

The answer – right now – within this inadequate system of democracy is simply this: NOTHING!

The People are totally powerless.

10 Do you remember Merriam Webster's definition of democracy in para 3?

A government in which the supreme power is vested in the people and exercised by them directly or indirectly through a system of representation usually involving periodically held free elections.

Supreme Power is vested in the people and exercised by them.
For that supreme power to be vested, it has to be given in the first place.
The People are in the FIRST PLACE – and they are the very People who those in government are in place to serve.

It appears that the People have forgotten this very basic point and they are not reminded of it by the government at any point in time. Instead, the government seek to remind the People who is in charge and demonstrate that erroneous principle by exercising the rulings they do.

11 So, the question for us all is this:

Given **There Is Nowhere To Go** – once a government has been elected by fair means or foul - what are we to do about that?

Do we all complain about the measures being forced upon us – accept our freedoms being consistently and gradually eroded – being told if we can work or not – being potentially poisoned or not – become slaves to the very persons who we elect to work FOR US and to serve OUR interests?

OR

Do we do something to exercise the Supreme Power we have by right.
Do we want a democracy – a real democracy – or are we happy with the dictatorship which has quietly slipped in through the back door?
