Standing back to look at things afresh is always a good idea – particularly at this mess we have all allowed to be created. It is the perfect way to start the process of making things right again – not that they've ever been right!

- 10. These contractors are charged with the task of looking after Big Stuff
- 11. That Big Stuff includes decisions at a county and national level
- 12. They include, defence, taxation, NHS and all country administration
- 13. The contractors get well paid for this work
- 14. They get chosen every 5yrs in a process called General Elections
- 15. The choice we get is not great and we are stuck with the result
- 16. That result is determined by whoever gets the most election votes
- 17. The winner might be chosen by polling as few as 20% of the total
- 18. This fact is not uncommon and is hardly a selling point for the system
- 19. Having got a determination by votes in an election we get this...
- 20. The contractors lose their understanding that THEY work for us
- 21. In essence we have NEVER reminded them that this IS fact
- 22. There is little sense if any that they need to report back to us
- 23. If we don't like what they have done there is no recourse for us
- 24. There is no sense that they are fully accountable to us
- 25. Transparency is not a given and there is no complaint process
- 26. The contractors actually make up their own rules to work by
- 27. The contractors also make up rules for us to work by without asking
- 28. In fact, they go about their business for us dictating to us
- 29. They even decide when we are going to fight others in the world
- 30. They treat us as if we were THEIR property like being their dog
- 31. But in truth we have allowed this to happen
- 32. We have not taught OUR dog that we are the Master
- 33. Our dog now sleeps in our bed whilst we sleep in theirs
- 34. And strangely, we have allowed this situation to exist without change

The above – admittedly – is a very simple description of the situation which prevails but, I would invite anyone to tell me where it's wrong.

To look at this situation from another perspective – I'd say that the situation we have all got ourselves into, is akin to this one.

Bear with me - in this little bit of fun - which I hope will clearly illustrate the situation we have all allowed to become a reality.

- 1. Being busy elsewhere, we need someone to take care of our garden
- 2. We take a look around at the available garden contractors
- 3. We assess what they say they will do believing in their word
- 4. We choose one who fits the bill best and agree a price
- 5. They begin work and initially all looks very rosy
- 6. Then later we find they are reorganising the garden layout
- 7. We didn't agree the alteration with them, but they did it anyway
- 8. They then started to say where we could go in our garden
- 9. They said it was for our safety and that is the only reason
- 10. They said we had to wear certain clothes also to protect us
- 11. They then used poisons to control weeds saying it wouldn't harm us
- 12. They then jacked their prices and we had no choice about paying
- 13. They even appointed subcontractors without any recourse to us

- 14. Feedback due about developments in the garden we didn't get
- 15. We made a complaint about clippings removal but weren't listened to
- 16. The impression we have now is that it is not OUR garden but THEIRS
- 17. We appear to be an annoying inconvenience to them and in their way
- 18. To top it all, they have now caused a dispute with our neighbour
- 19. The cost of resolving this and harm caused they're not bothered about
- 20. Shouldn't the garden contractor be working for us?
- 21. Shouldn't the garden contractor be doing what we want?
- 22. Shouldn't we be able to get shot of them when we want to?
- 23. How on earth did we get to this?

This is a very simple analogy of course, but it's not one that is so different to the reality we are all living in now – and have been for a very long time.

We have allowed this situation to evolve this way and we have done nothing about it. In fairness, the situation has evolved somewhat gradually – so gradually in fact, that few of us noticed the creep in the control they exercise. It is similar to not noticing how the clouds above us are changing shape. The change is slow and gradual – whilst all the time our focus has been elsewhere on our work – looking at the ground in our own gardens – too busy to see the slow changes going on over our heads.

The reason we are doing this analysis now though, is that there are some very disturbing things happening in our world – and many of us have not noticed these things – a bit like the clouds changing shape.
