- 6 The question left hanging for us all - is how serious is this problem really? Further, it is so strange to us at CONNECT, that so much pressure is being applied to become inoculated - even cash incentives in some cases - when there is so little evidence of a problem.
- 7 The YouGov poll which Richie Allen details, indicates that 23% of people have parked the app and will not be guided by it. We know ourselves of many people that won't play this game. They either don't go out so much now - or when they do, they leave a false ID with the restaurant or bar. Many self-employed people simply cannot afford to self-isolate - believing as they do - there is no need for it anyway - being the risk to them and others is minimal.
